- TRICS® goes web-based
- Off-Line version of web system
- Upgrade to Google Maps

TRICS[®] Goes Web-Based

- Users can log on from any PC
- Quicker fixes for system bugs
- More regular database updates
- Opportunities for web-based interaction



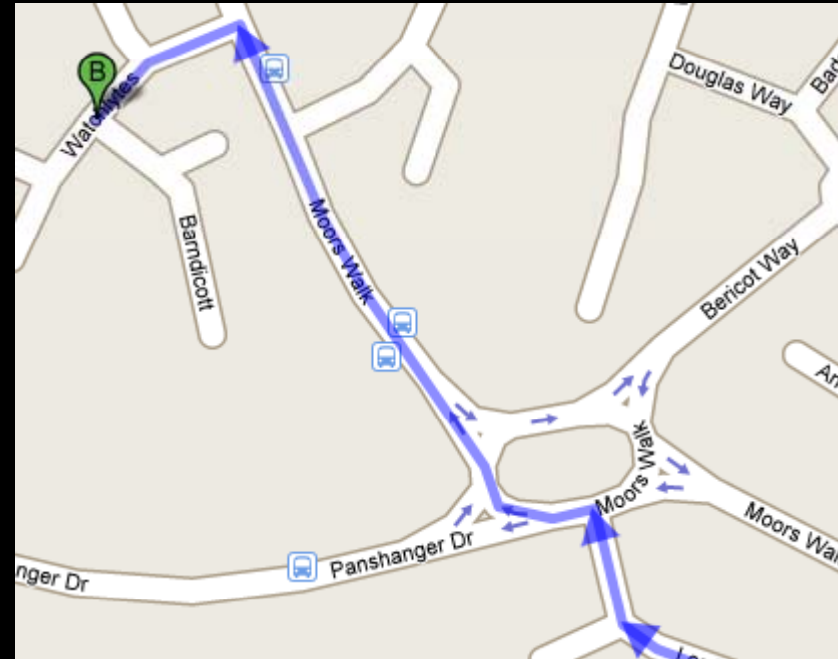
Off-Line Version Of Web System




- Allows use of up-to-date TRICS® version off-line
- Improved speed and efficiency
- Handy for when there is no internet connection
- Prompts for update downloads

Upgrade To Google Maps

- Google Maps replaces Multimaps facility
- Quicker and more user-friendly
- Allows for greater flexibility and detail
- Integral part of our new Accessibility feature



Accessibility Feature

- A new approach to Accessibility
 - Easily obtainable data for new sites
 - Incorporates Google Maps
 - Incorporates distance to local amenities and Census information
 - Discussed in more detail later on

Journey Purpose For SAM Surveys

- SAM is the Standard Assessment Methodology for the monitoring of Travel Plans
- First pilot surveys undertaken in 2005
- Enhanced data section on Travel Plan Monitoring within SAM sites
- Journey purpose to be introduced
- More detail to follow in later presentation

More Frequent Database Updates

- Windows version updated every 6 months
- Web-based TRICS survey database to be updated every 3 months
- Major developments to program remain at 6 month intervals



Survey Programme 2008

- 270 surveys taking place in 2008
- Record 170 multi-modal surveys being undertaken
- All TRICS® regions in the UK and Ireland to be covered
- Wide range of land uses covered
