- Location of TRICS member organisations

- General current levels of data by land use

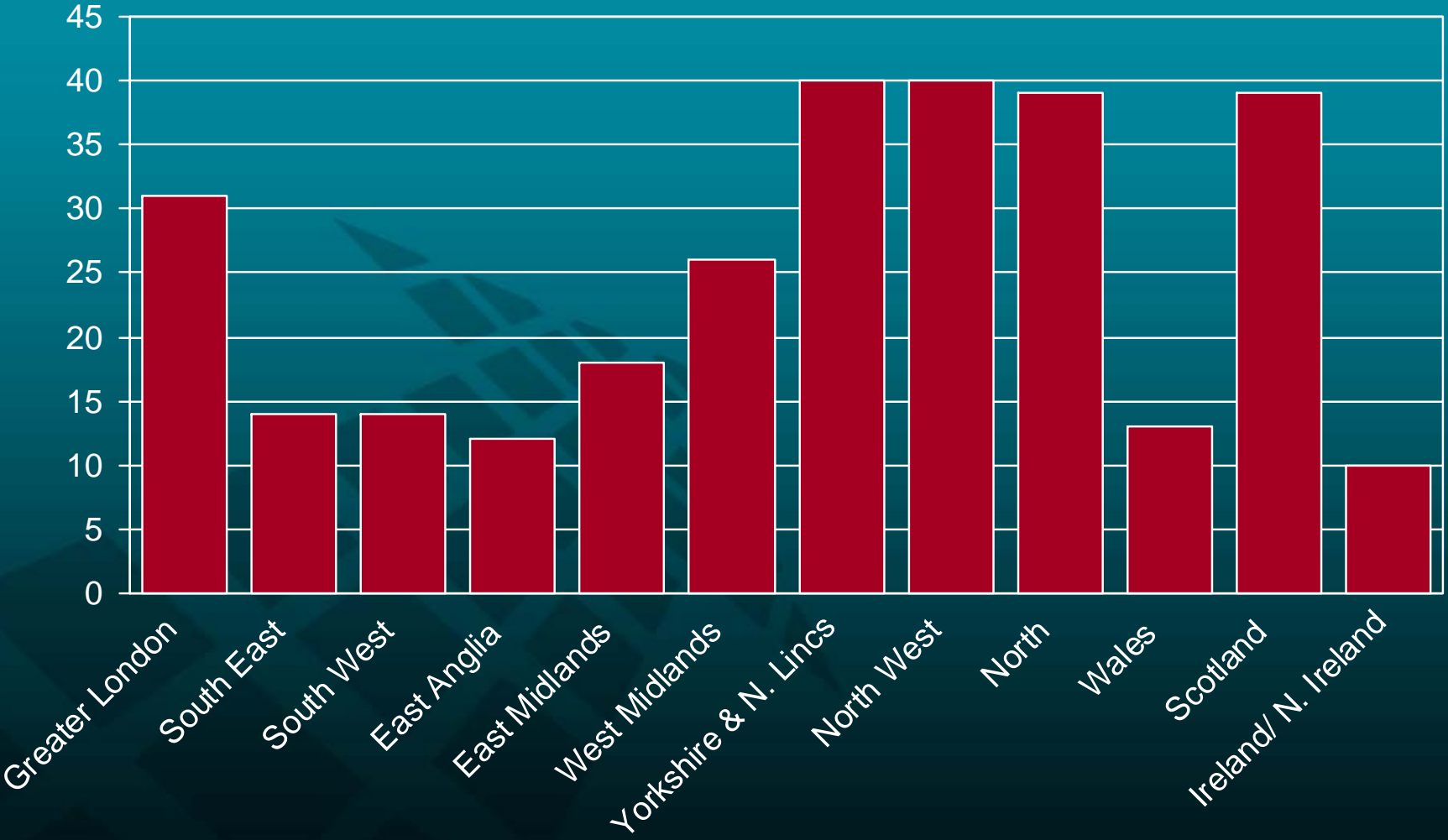
2004 – Programme Overview

- 205 traffic surveys and 91 multi-modal surveys
- Regional packages tendered by region (12 in total)
- Wider mix of areas and land use categories
- All surveys to be undertaken by end of October 2004
- All data to be supplied by end of December 2004

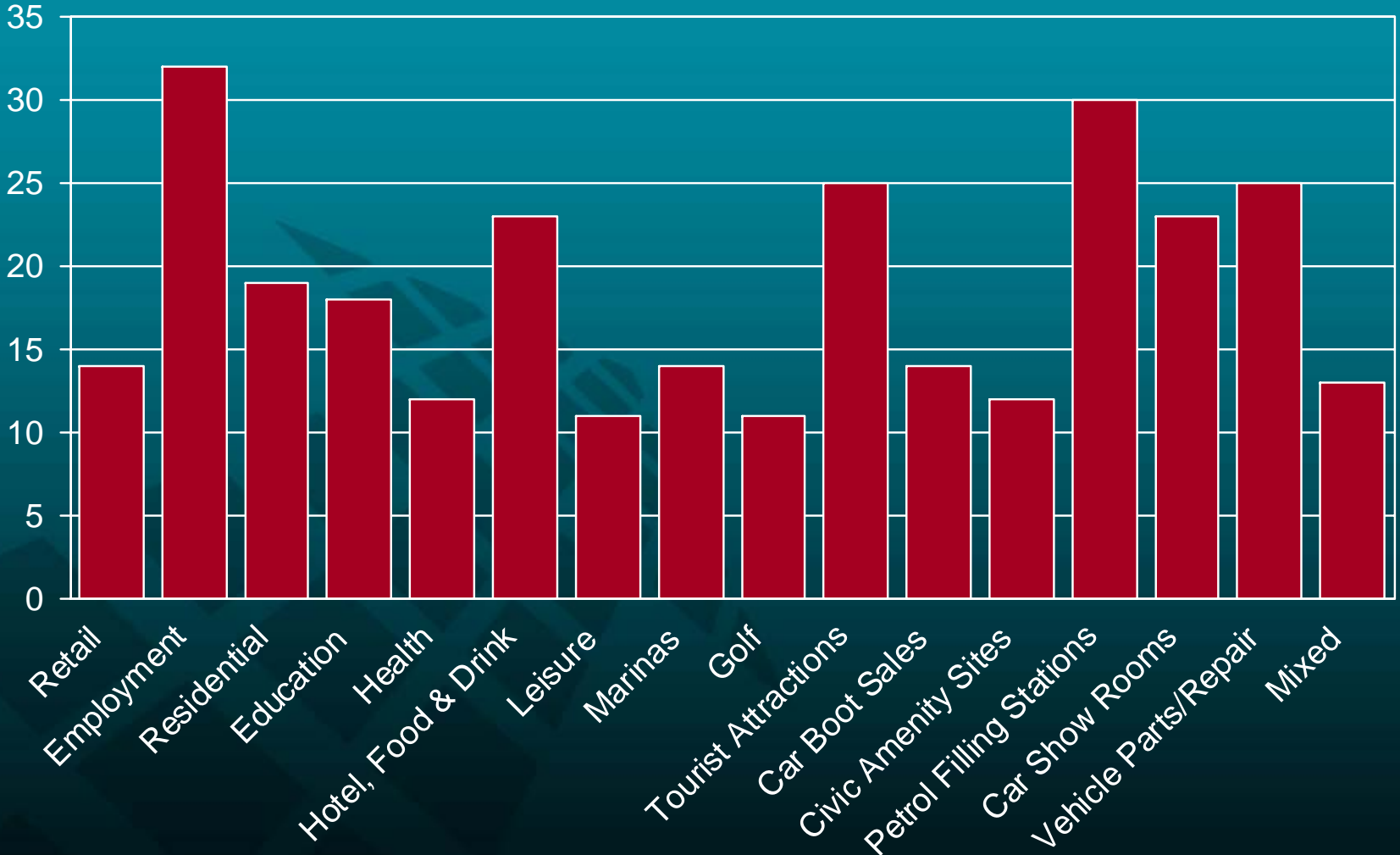
2004 – Data Collection Procedure

- Multi-modal site visits identify potential survey locations
- Shortlists of survey locations are sent out to tender
- Winning bidders asked to identify potential traffic survey sites
- Final list of traffic and multi-modal sites agreed
- Survey permissions obtained and dates scheduled
- Traffic and multi-modal counts undertaken
- Data collection forms completed and supplied for input
- Data input and subject to validation testing
- Confirmation of site acceptance and invoicing for data

2004 – Sites by Region



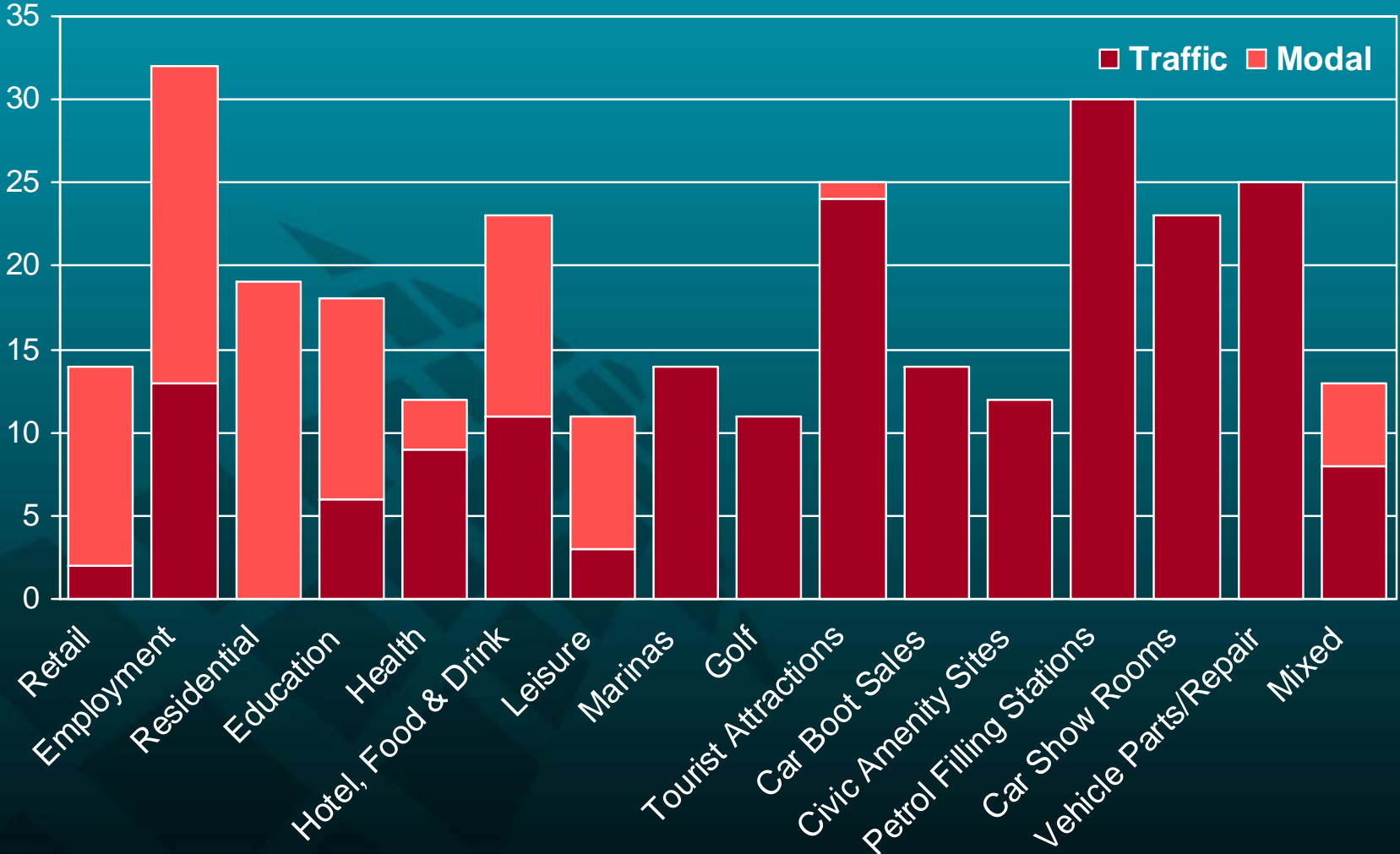
2004 – Sites by Land Use



Traffic/Multi-modal Split

- 31% of all surveys undertaken now multi-modal
- Highest number of multi-modal surveys undertaken in a year (91)
- Analysis of multi-modal surveys can now be more detailed
